SUBJECT: Auditing Classes

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2000; Revised: March 14, 2013

Students who do not wish to receive credit or a grade for a course may audit the course if the prerequisites have been met, sufficient prior knowledge exists to warrant auditing the course, or there is a compelling reason to justify auditing the course.

Registration for auditing can be accomplished only during the late registration period and will be allowed on a space available basis. Students who audit courses pay the same fees as those enrolling for credit. Registration for audit can be changed to credit no later than the last day of late registration. Registration for credit cannot be changed to audit.

Students with mitigating circumstances may request an exception to this policy from the Provost/Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs.
