THIS IS A SPECIAL ADMISSIONS PROGRAM:

This is a 12 month Special Admissions Paramedic Training Program. Students **MUST** be Licensed in the state of Tennessee as an EMT Advanced to be considered for admission.

Deadline to apply is July 1st. Application by June 1st is preferred. Testing and interview process is required for selection.

MALPRACTICE: Students are required to obtain malpractice insurance for participation in the Paramedic program. Malpractices insurance should be good for one year from the beginning of the paramedic program

PROGRAM COSTS: in addition to tuition and lab fees, students may have additional costs ranging from \$400-\$1,000 to cover uniforms, physical examinations, lab tests, immunizations, certification and licensure fees.
