### Milestone Courses

Criminal and/or other types of background checks, possibly at the student's expense, may be a requirement of some courses in this degree program. The ability to complete cooperative training, internships, field experiences, and educational practicums may be based on the results of these background checks.

### General Advising Notes

Most ECED courses have either field experience or service learning requirements.

ECED 2335 may require 45 clock hours of field experience.

ECED 2365 may require 90 clock hours of field experience.
